Sunset River Cruise of the 6 Bridges of Porto

This journey on a traditional Portuguese riverboat offers you a unique view into Porto. In addition to the rich landscape and spectacular views, sail past the six bridges that make the connection between Porto and Vila Nova de Gaia. Start by passing the Ribeira district, then the famous Dom Luís I bridge, The Serra do Pilar Monastery, the stylish Infante Bridge, the Don Maria Pia - the oldest bridge, its "replacement" the São João bridge, and the Freixo bridge. Discover the story-telling bridges that have helped intertwine cultures and reveal the scenery of a World Heritage city.

Coimbra

Dating back to the 13th century, Coimbra is the former capital city of Portugal and home of the oldest University in Portugal. The University's library is housed in the former Royal Palace and is a must-see. Climb to the top of the bell tower for panoramic views. Also visit the old Romanesque cathedral, the Quinta das Lagrimas gardens and the Almedina Arch and Tower.

Visit Fatima, the pilgrimage altar and center of Christian faith to visit Our Lady of Fatima Shrine,



including the Apparition Chapel. Housed in the Chapel is the Our Lady of Fatima Statue representing the spot of the apparition. You will also visit the Basilica where the tombs of the children are located and Holy Trinity Church, considered the fourth largest in the world in terms of capacity.

Panoramic Orientation Tour

Fado Dance and Dinner Show

Fado, the "heart of Lisbon", is a style of music and dance that originated in Lisbon in the early 19th century. Performed in small restaurants and in the streets and squares of the old parts of the city like Alfama and Mouraria, it represented a way for the poor and uneducated (like the fishermen) to express themselves. As it gained in popularity, Fado became one of the most revered aspects of the Lisbon experience. It is still one of the most emotional and touching experiences for visitors to Lisbon. Experience Fado while enjoying dinner at a traditional Portuguese restaurant.
