<u>Glacier Bay National Park (Scenic Cruising)</u> 9:15am - 7:30pm

The 3.3-million-acre Glacier Bay National Park, a UNESCO-listed treasure, will both astound and intrigue. The magnificent Margerie Glacier is sure to impress with its dramatic blue spires. Beyond the ice, you'll see towering snowcapped mountains, deep fjords and freshwater streams. You may even catch a glimpse of humpback whales, sea otters and porpoises as they swim through the bay below, which you can learn about on board from knowledgeable Park Rangers.
